Indiana ranks nationwide:

First in production of:

- ▶ wood office furniture (by value - US \$552 mil. and by payroll - US \$20.5 mil.)
- ▶ manufactured homes (by # of companies - 38 and by payroll - US \$214 mil.)

Second in production of:

- ▶ manufactured homes (by value - US \$1.25 billion)
- ▶ wood office furniture (by # of employees - 5,113)
- ▶ hardwood veneer & plywood (by payroll - US \$61 mil.)
- ▶ hardwood veneer & plywood (by # of companies - 28)

Third in production of:

- ▶ wood kitchens & counter tops (by value - US \$669 mil.)
- ▶ cut stock & resawed lumber (by value - US \$403 mil.)
- ▶ veneer, plywood & engineered wood products (by value - US \$440 mil.)

Fourth in production of:

- ▶ blinds & shades (by # of employees - 1,251)
- ▶ prefabricated wood buildings (by payroll - US \$30 mil.)

Fifth in production of:

- ▶ upholstered household furniture (by value - US \$269 mil.)

Indiana Wood Industry Facts

The Forest Resource

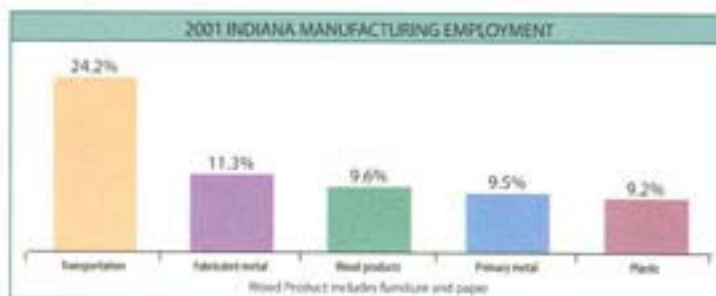
- ▶ producing high-quality hardwood lumber; proportion of highest quality logs (grades 1 & 2) increased from 26% to 49% between 1986 and 1998
- ▶ 4.3 million acres of timber land; an 11% increase since 1967
- ▶ growing 641 million board feet of sawtimber annually; a 284% increase since 1967
- ▶ removing 480 million board feet annually; a 39% increase since 1967. A growth to removal ratio of 1:34

Primary Industry (logging, sawmills, veneer, plywood, etc.)

- ▶ 601 firms comprise the primary industry in Indiana
- ▶ 21,692 individuals are employed by the primary industry
- ▶ \$563 million dollars in compensation paid by the primary industry
- ▶ \$1.18 billion dollars in value are added to the states economy by the primary industry

Secondary Industry (furniture, fixtures, etc.)

- ▶ 509 firms comprise the secondary wood products manufacturing industry in Indiana
- ▶ 19 of the 300 largest U.S. furniture and related products manufacturers have headquarters in Indiana
- ▶ 69 of the 300 largest U.S. furniture and related products manufacturers have plants in Indiana
- ▶ 26,150 individuals are employed by the secondary industry
- ▶ \$666 million in compensation paid by the secondary industry
- ▶ \$1.58 billion in value are added to the states economy by the secondary industry; an increase of 17% since 1997
